## **Macroeconomics of East Asia:**

The *International Review of Economics & Finance* invites manuscripts for a Special Issue on Macroeconomics of East Asia, scheduled for publication in late 2007.

The Special Issue focuses on macroeconomic issues pertaining to the East Asian region. As the countries of East Asia have experienced rapid economic development, a wide variety of challenges for economic management have arisen. We are interested in papers that focus on theoretical issues that can be directly applied to the East Asian experience such as:

- o international capital flows and the current account,
- o financial crises
- o trade integration, terms of trade and business cycles
- o monetary policy, inflation targeting and exchange rate regimes
- o economic development and growth
- o demographics and fiscal policy

We are also interested in empirical and quantitative papers that use East Asian data to answer questions about macroeconomic issues relevant to the region.

Each submission should include two PDF files of the manuscript, one with author information and the other without author information for a blind review process. Total size of a paper may not be more than 30 double-spaced pages. The submission fee is \$60 US for all authors.
