Research in Trade: Where do we go from here?

The *International Review of Economics & Finance* invites manuscripts for a Special Issue on Research in Trade: Where do we go from here?, scheduled for publication in late 2007.

In recent years there has been a surge of work in trade that integrates trade with frontier work in other areas. The purpose of this issue will be to provide perspective on the various approaches taken and where this work might go in the future. Particular areas of interest include Political Economy of Trade, Heterogeneous Firm Settings in Trade, Trade and Growth, and Contracting and Intermediaries in Trade. The deadline for paper submission is December 15th 2006. Papers will be peer reviewed on an expedited track. Authors will be notified within 3 months of this deadline of the decision on their paper

Electronic Submission Procedure: All manuscripts should be double-spaced and submitted in PDF format to Kala Krishna at kmk4@psu.edu with a copy sent to Sandi Lucas at sj11@psu.edu before 12/15/2006. Each submission should include two PDF files of the manuscript, one with author information and the other without author information for a blind review process.
